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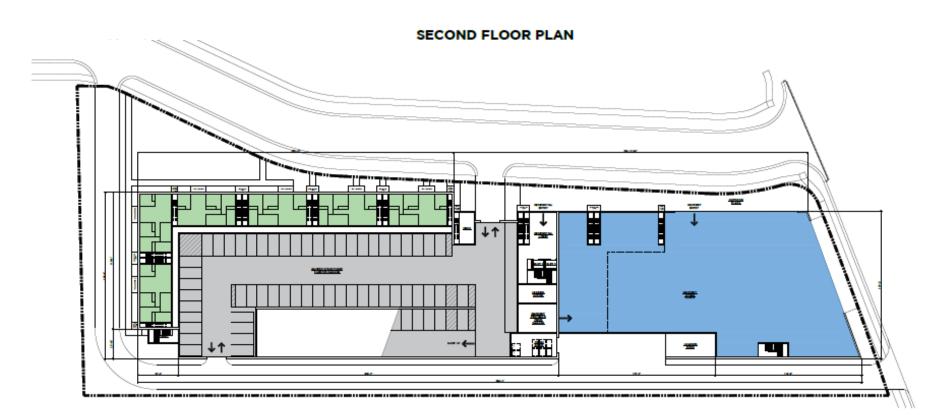

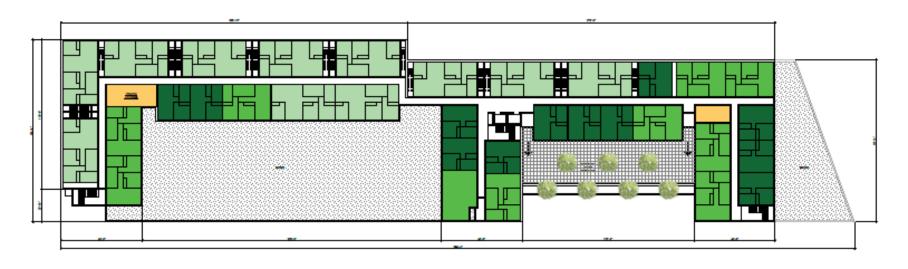

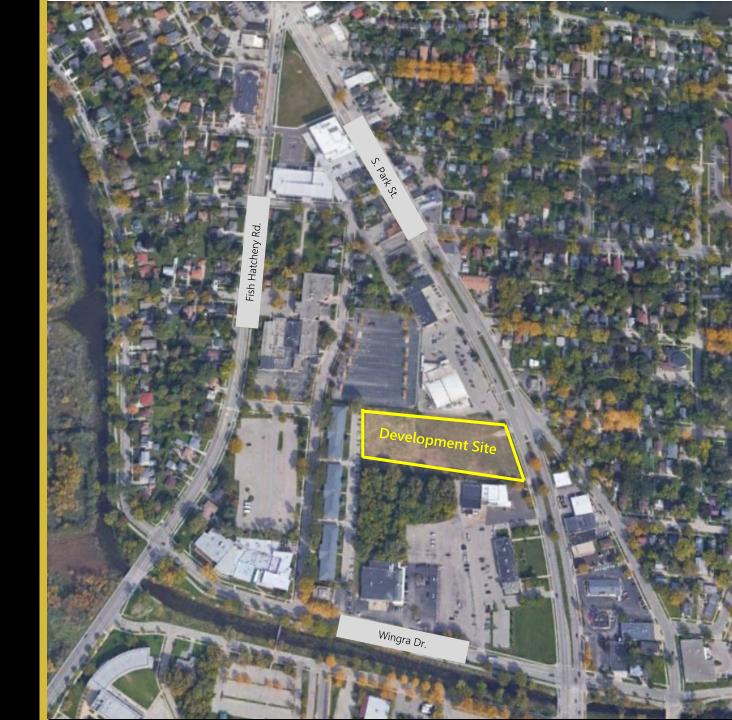


SIXTH FLOOR PLAN

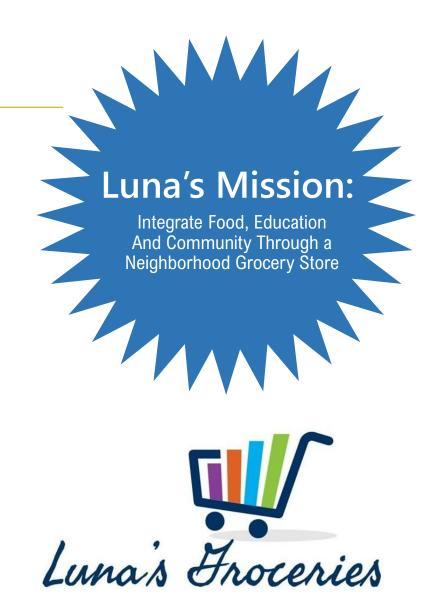

- 3. Final Stage

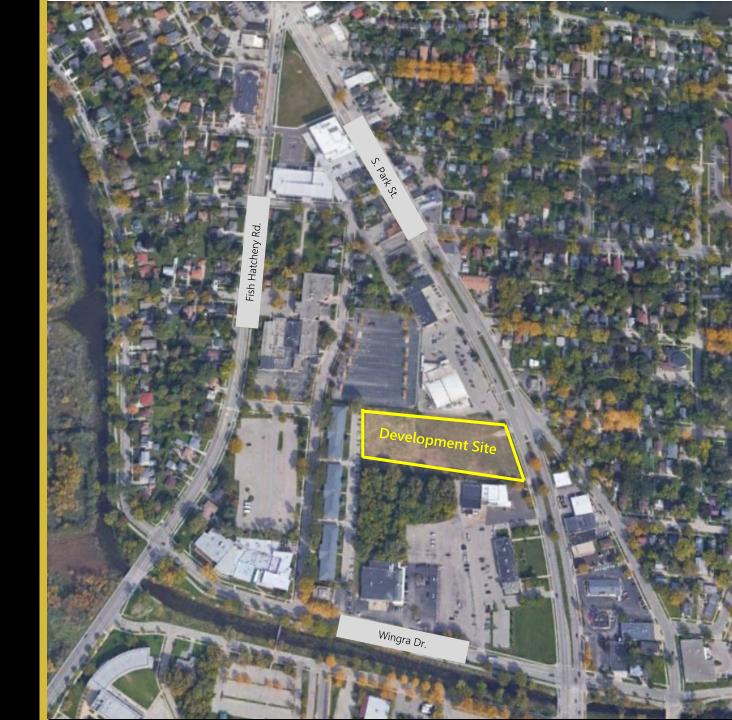


Grocery Store Design Process Timeline

Summer 2020	Location and size project infrastructure (loading dock, garbage, access points)
Fall 2020	Interior conceptual layout
Summer 2021	Interior design
Fall 2021	Begin product selection (40% to be determined prior to opening. Remainder to be determined by shoppers and residents of apartments)
January 2022	Build out

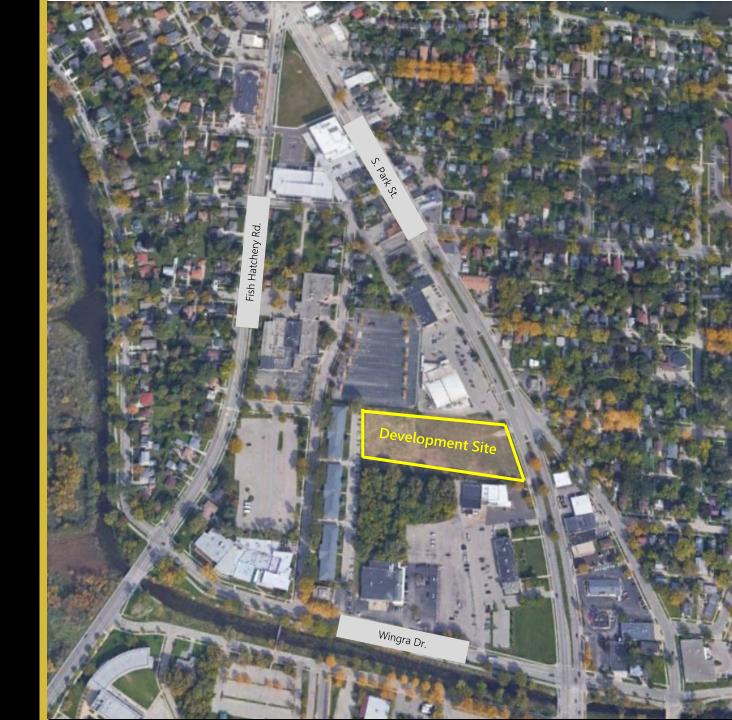
